For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice; Findings: General: Based on observation during a tour of the Toddler Classroom, the surveyor found that the lighting was not adequate light at naptime to view children as they sleep; therefore, staff did not adequately have the children in scope of vision. During interview, staff stated that they would have additional lighting during naptime. The surveyor did not observed the staff person working with children. During interview, staff-in-charge confirmed that the Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check and Criminal Records Background Check have not been submitted for the staff person. Based on review of the Kentucky National Background Check Service, the staff person did not have a completed background check. 2. A staff's (DOH: 03/16/21) file did not contain a completed Criminal Records Background Check. The staff's file contained a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check. The staff's file contained a completed Child Abuse/Neglect Background Check only dated for 03/10/21. The surveyor did not observed the staff person working with children. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the Criminal Records Background Check was completed; however, she was unable to locate the documentation. Staff-in-charge also stated that the staff person is the cook and does not supervise children. Based on review of

General: Based on observation during a tour of the center, the surveyor found that the seven (7) sinks located in the center were not equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Therefore, the sink are not in compliance with regulations. During interview, staff stated they would have the landlord correct the temperature of the water.
