General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) caregivers each hired on 7/30/20, had a TB document on file that was dated 9/12/19. A caregiver hired on 6/30/21, did not have TB documentation on file.

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no caregiver present with children with current first aid and CPR certification. Staff's certification expired on 10/17/21.
