DCC-501, Disclosures to Be Provided to and Signed by the Applicant Child Care Staff Member; and (c) Log on to the NBCP portal and enter the prospective child care staff member's demographic information for a check of the: 1. Child abuse and neglect central registry pursuant to 922 KAR 1:470; 2. National Crime Information Center's National Sex Offender Registry in accordance with 34 U.S.C. 20921; and 3. Sex Offender Registry established in accordance with KRS 17.500 through 17.580. Findings: General: Based on review of documentation, staff member hired 8/14/2020, did not have a completed background check on file. The CAN report and the state-based background check had not been mailed or completed prior to hire. It is important to note that fingerprint based background checks are not available during the COVID-19 state of emergency.
