An investigation of an alleged complaint, including an allegation of child abuse or neglect pursuant to KRS 620.030; and 2. Unannounced inspections;	
Findings:	
General: Based on interview, the Director refused to copy or allow the Surveyor to take a picture of the sign in sheet of the day in question (3/25/22) in the third allegation while conducting the investigation at the center on 4/8/22. The office Manager contacted the Director on 4/13/22 around 9:50 AM. The Director finally emailed a copy of the sign in sheet at 3:25 PM that day after the office Manager spoke with her.	
225 - Licensee Responsibility	Not In Compliance
922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General. (1) A licensee shall: (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.	
Findings:	
General: Based on interview, the child care center failed to provide extra clothing for a child after an accident resulting in the child having to sit in a chair for a prolonged period of time. The child was not allowed to play during the time it took for her clothes to be washed and dried.	
715 - Diapers/Clean Clothing Supply	Not In Compliance
922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements. (6) An adequate quantity of freshly laundered or disposable diapers and clean clothing shall be available.	
Findings:	
General: Based on interview, this regulation was not met. The child care center does not have extra clothes at the center in case of accidents or spills. The center may have a policy requiring parents to provide extra clothing for their child but this does not negate the child care center's responsibility to have additional clothing for a child if the parent did not provide any.
