The caregiver was under the age of eighteen and was not under direct supervision of a qualified caregiver, therefore, adequate supervision was not provided

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a caregiver hired 02/26/2021 supervised six (6) school-age children alone for approximately ten (10) minutes on 04/14/2021. The caregiver was under the age of eighteen and was not under direct supervision of a qualified caregiver, therefore, staff/child ratios were not maintained.
