- (1) A licensee shall:
- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the licensee failed to protect and assure the safety of each child. On 4/14/21, the facility reported that on 4/13/21 at approximately 4:30PM a Pre-K male child hit another Pre-K male child while playing on the playground. As a result, a staff person instructed the child that initially hit to stand up against the fence. The staff person then instructed the child victim to hit the other child back in the face. At this point, the child victim hit the child standing up against the fence with an open-hand across the face. A second staff person, who was present on the playground at the time, observed the incident and immediately lined the children up to return inside. The staff person was terminated as a result of the incident.

(m) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in 922 KAR 2:280;

#### Findings:

Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. One staff person (hire date: 3/3/21) was observed working alone with nine children (two-year-olds) during the inspection. This staff person had a completed criminal records check (CRC) on file; however, she did not have evidence or results of a child abuse/neglect check (CAN) on file.
- 2. One staff person (hire date: 3/17/21) was observed working alone with one child in the Infant 2 Classroom during the inspection. This staff person had a completed CRC on file; however, she did not have evidence or results of a CAN check on file.

- (c) Each plan of correction submitted by the child-care center to the cabinet during the current licensure year;
- (d) Information on the Kentucky Consumer Product Safety Program and the program's Web site as specified in KRS 199.897;
- (e) A description of services provided by the child-care center, including:
- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The statement of deficiencies and plan of correction from the 12/1/20 post-preliminary inspection was not posted.
