### Findings:

Based on interview and review of documentation the child care center failed to comply with regulatory requirements in regard to the health, safety and comfort of a child in care. Interview and review of documentation revealed a staff member acknowledged that he/she placed Germ X (a form of hand sanitizer) on a child's thumb which made the child scream each time he/she tried to suck his/her thumb.

- (11) A child shall not be subjected to:
- (a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);

#### Findings:

Based on interview and review of documentation the child care center failed to comply with regulatory programming requirements. Interview and review of documentation revealed a staff member acknowledged that he/she placed Germ X (a form of hand sanitizer) on a child's thumb as a corrective action, which made the child scream each time he/she tried to suck his/her thumb. Interview with a staff member revealed he/she had told a child if he/she did not quit sucking his/her thumb then he/she (staff member)would put hot sauce on it.
