922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.
(1) A licensee shall:
(a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
(b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

Findings:

Based on interview and review of documentation the child care center failed to comply with regulatory requirements in regard to the health, safety and comfort of a child in care. Interview and review of documentation revealed a staff member acknowledged that he/she placed Germ X (a form of hand sanitizer) on a child's thumb which made the child scream each time he/she tried to suck his/her thumb.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.
(11) A child shall not be subjected to:
(a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);
(b) Loud, profane, threatening, frightening, humiliating, or abusive language; or
(c) Discipline that is associated with:
1. Rest;
2. Toileting;
3. Play time; or
4. Food.

Findings:

Based on interview and review of documentation the child care center failed to comply with regulatory programming requirements. Interview and review of documentation revealed a staff member acknowledged that he/she placed Germ X (a form of hand sanitizer) on a child's thumb as a corrective action, which made the child scream each time he/she tried to suck his/her thumb. Interview with a staff member revealed he/she had told a child if he/she did not quit sucking his/her thumb then he/she (staff member) would put hot sauce on it.
