## 210 - Licensee Responsibility

(a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

#### Findings:

Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

1. One staff person (hire date: 6/16/21) was observed working alone with four preschool children during the visit. This staff person had a child abuse/neglect check (CAN) application that had been submitted for processing on 5/26/21; however, the results had not yet been obtained. This staff person did not have evidence or results of a criminal records check (CRC) on file.

2. One staff person (hire date: 6/16/21) was observed working alone with seven preschool children during the visit. This staff person had a CAN check application that had been submitted for processing on 6/8/21; however, the results had not yet been obtained. This staff person did not have evidence or results of a CRC on file.

3. One staff person (hire date: 6/14/21) was observed working alone with 13 school age children during the visit. This staff person had a CAN check application that had been submitted for processing on 6/4/21; however, the results had not yet been obtained. This staff person did not have evidence or results of a CRC on file.

The staff person in charge acknowledged this finding and stated that she had contacted a director at a different location to find out how to get background checks done in the KARES system

Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

1. One staff person (hire date: 6/16/21) was observed working alone with four preschool children during the visit. This staff person had a child abuse/neglect check (CAN) application that had been submitted for processing on 5/26/21; however, the results had not yet been obtained. This staff person did not have evidence or results of a criminal records check (CRC) on file.

2. One staff person (hire date: 6/16/21) was observed working alone with seven preschool children during the visit. This staff person had a CAN check application that had been submitted for processing on 6/8/21; however, the results had not yet been obtained. This staff person did not have evidence or results of a CRC on file.

3. One staff person (hire date: 6/14/21) was observed working alone with 13 school age children during the visit. This staff person had a CAN check application that had been submitted for processing on 6/4/21; however, the results had not yet been obtained. This staff person did not have evidence or results of a CRC on file.

The staff person in charge acknowledged this finding and stated that she had contacted a director at a different location to find out how to get background checks done in the KARES system.
