Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. In the bathroom of Room #1, there was a plunger stored next to the toilet. This manner of storage is not sanitary and promotes the spread of germs

- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:

- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Two staff did not have proof of education on file. These staff were both substitutes that were hired on 4/20/2021 and 2/07/2022.

405 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff member hired on 6/15/2021, did not have current negative TB documentation on file. The staff member had a chest X-ray on file that was dated 01/13/2020. Child-care center staff shall provide prior to employment and every two years thereafter: a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis, or a copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Room #5, the Two-Year-Old Room, contained a staff purse on the floor near a storage cabinet. The purse was within reach of a child; therefore, accessible.

570 - Items Accessible Only During Activity

- (8) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care unless under direct supervision and part of planned program of instruction:
- (a) Knives and sharp objects;
- (b) Litter and rubbish;

Findings

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Room #1, the Pre-K/School-Age Room, contained a pair of adult scissors (pink handle) located on top of the home living kitchen set. The staff member was located at a table in the front of room doing a coloring activity with a group of the children.

585 - Premises Requirements

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(1) The premises shall be:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Room #3, the School-Age Room, contained tape residue on the inside of the door to the classroom that leads to the hallway.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Room #1, the Pre-K/School-Age Room, contained a rug in front of the hand washing sink that was stained and dirty on the surface.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The chest freezer in the kitchen contained an oven thermometer and it did not provide the correct temperature range of numbers on the thermometer for a freezer; therefore, the temperature of the freezer and its contents could not be verified.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A child enrolled on 3/20/2021, did not have a physician's name or phone number on file. This child's enrollment paperwork also did not list a preferred hospital.
- 2. A child enrolled on 5/31/2021, did not have a preferred hospital listed in the file.
- 3. A child enrolled on 8/06/2020, did not have a physician's name or phone number on file. This child's enrollment paperwork also did not list a preferred hospital.
- 4. A child enrolled on 1/04/2021, did not have a preferred hospital listed in the enrollment paperwork.
