Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) There were two uncovered electrical outlets in the Three-Year-Old classroom. These outlets were located next to where the napping cots were stored.
- 2.) In the Toddler classroom, there was a chair that was sitting on top of the napping cots. In addition, there were two stacks of chairs that had approximately five to six chairs per stack. This is a tipping hazard and poses a risk to the children in the classroom.

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found that one staff member did not have educational documentation in their personnel file. The date of hire for this staff person is 01/20/2022.

435 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) Three staff members did not complete the required 15 hours of cabinet approved early care and education training between July 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021.
- 2.) Three staff members did not complete the required orientation training within the 90 days of employment. Staff member hired on 11/16/2020, did not complete training until 12/21/2021. Staff member hired on 08/16/2021, did not complete the training until 12/22/2021. Staff member hired on 05/26/2021, did not complete the training until 12/21/2021. A review of ECE-TRIS was completed and confirmed these findings.

General: Based on observation, it was found in the Three-Year-Old classroom, the contact paper was coming off of the closet door.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1.) In the Pre-K classroom, there was missing paint on the walls. This was in different areas around the classroom. In addition, there were two areas where things had been pulled off the walls, which left residue and had pulled some paint off the wall.
- 2.) In the Three-Year-Old classroom, there was numerous amounts of crayon marks on the wall in different areas of the classroom.

This product was not being stored properly, which could lead to spoilage. The surveyor entered this classroom at approximately 10:00AM, therefore breakfast was over and it was not yet lunch time.

General: Based on review of documentation, two children's files did not include a preferred hospital. The dates of enrollment for these children are 07/19/2021, and 11/19/2021.
