Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, on 6/16/2022 eight children were signed in before 7:30 a.m. Per review of the name and age documentation, the youngest child in this group is aged one (Child #1). The name to face sheet documents one staff member present during this time. The one-year-old child was checked out at 7:30 a.m.. The class became over ratio at 7:20 a.m. when three children arrived bringing the total number of children in care to eight. The classroom was over ratio between 7:20 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. Additionally, on 6/16/2022 the name to face sheet documentation lists thirteen children present with one staff member. Based on the date of birth documentation for the center, two children in this group are aged three. No out times are recorded for any children after 7:50 a.m. on this date. The classroom was out of ratio by one child for an unknown amount of time on this date per documentation on the name to face sheet.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, at 11:35 a.m. the surveyor entered the Preschool classroom and observed a staff member to change a child's diaper. The child that was diapered did not wash their hands after the diaper change.
