Findings:

General: Based on observation, the family child care home failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation in the programming area revealed a large, brown leather couch with a torn cushion, exposing foam padding and was accessible to the children.

(3) The areas of the home that are accessible to children in care shall be free from items harmful to children including the following items:

- (a) Cleaning supplies, poisons, paints, and insecticides;
- (b) Knives, scissors, and sharp objects;
- (c) Power tools, lawn mowers, hand tools, nails, and other equipment;
- (d) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, combustibles, and flammable liquids;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the family child care home failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation in the bathroom revealed cleaning products in a cabinet beneath the sink which was not locked, allowing accessibility to children.

- (2) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located near or in close proximity to toilets;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap and single use, disposable hand drying material;
- (e) Equipped with an easily cleanable, covered waste receptacle; and
- (f) Near or in close proximity to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the family child care home provider/applicant failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation revealed only bar soap was available for handwashing with no liquid soap.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the family child care home failed to maintain regulatory hygienic requirements. Observation failed to reveal a diapering surface to be used during diapering. Interview with the provider revealed a designated surface had not been determined or purchased to lay a child on while diapering.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the family child care home provider failed to maintain medication in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation in the refrigerator revealed several bottles of over the counter drugs including pepto-bismol and liquid cold medications which failed to be locked.
