General: Based on review of documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. A review of staff files during the inspection found one staff person did not have the date of employment listed in their file. The staff person in charge reviewed information on her computer and then verbally identified the date 3/24/22, as the hire date. However, the date of hire was not maintained in the personnel file.

- 1. Current rates for child care; and
- 2. Each service charged separately and in addition to the basic rate for child care;
- (f) Minimum staff-to-child ratios and group size established in 922 KAR 2:120; and
- (g) Daily planned program.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The infant classroom had a planned program of daily activities (lesson plan) posted; however, no date was listed.
