- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, sharp points were on the bottom edge of a shelf on the children's cubby in the three-year-olds' room. The area was approximately six (6) inches long.

General: Based on review of documentation, the center had an aerial view that did not include a written transportation route to and from Beaver Dam Baptist Church.

General: Based on observation, there was no CPR mouth shield in the first aid supplies on the center's van.
