- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) Staff members hired 3/30/2015 and 8/13/2007 last completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 6/29/2016; this training exceeds five years.
- 2.) Staff members hired 8/13/2007, 9/15/2004, 12/20/2018, and 3/30/2015 did not complete fifteen hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training for the July 1 June 30 year of employment.

A review of ECE-TRIS supports these findings.

- 1.) There were areas of chipping paint in the Pre-kindergarten classroom bathroom.
- 2.) A sticky substance was on the wall above the sensory tape in the One-year-old classroom.
- 3.) There were several dead insects located within the Infant classroom.

- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

General: Based on review of documentation, one child did not have a physician contact number listed in their enrollment information.
