Two staff (DOH: 06/10/2017 and 08/10/2015) did not complete the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that in the two and three year old classroom, there was a bottle of sculpting gel and glaze located on a desk in the classroom. This item was labeled "keep out of reach of children", and it was in reach of the children in the classroom.

- (i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the following was found: 1.) There was not a fire drill completed in March of 2018. 2.) There was no evidence of a tornado drill being completed at the facility since January of 2018. 3.) There was no evidence of an earthquake drill being completed at the facility since August of 2017. The Director stated that the Assisstant Director is in charge of keeping up with the drills.
