Findings:

General: Based on observation, the walls contained chipped paint in the Migrant Toddler, Migrant XPA, Infant, and Classroom A rooms.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap:
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, one of the handwashing sinks located in the bathroom was not in proper working order within the Migrant Toddler room.

General: Based on observation, in the Migrant Toddler room, the toilet was not flushed after use.

- 1. Upon arrival at the center;
- 2. After toileting or assisting a child in toileting;
- 3. Before and after diapering each child;
- 4. After wiping or blowing a child's or own nose;
- 5. After handling animals;
- 6. After caring for a sick child;
- 7. Before and after feeding a child or eating;
- 8. Before dispensing medication;
- 9. After smoking or vaping; and
- 10. If possible, before administering first aid; and
- (d) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (c) of this subsection. The staff shall wash the staff's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, in the Infant room, the staff member was observed wiping a child's nose and the staff member did not wash her hands afterwards.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the daily planned program of activities (lesson plan) posted in the Migrant XPA room was no longer current. The posted daily planned program of activities was dated for the previous week.
