<p>General: Based on Observation, a half ounce tube of Hyland's teething gel and a small tube of Orajel were not labeled to indicate to whom they belonged and were stored in an unlocked middle drawer of a three (3) drawer plastic storage unit near the sink in the infants' and toddlers' restroom. In addition, an ounce tube of Boudreaux's Butt Paste was also stored unlocked in the middle drawer of a three (3) drawer plastic storage unit near the sink in the infants' and toddlers' restroom.</p>
