Findings:

General: Based on observation, a cabinet locking mechanism within the Two-Year-Old classroom was not in working order; the cabinet housed a container with screws and two screwdrivers.

General: Based on observation, the diaper changing pad within the Infant classroom had dirt and debris within the crevices. In addition, there were small holes in the vinyl covering.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) A small branch was located on top of the mulch on the playground. The staff person stated that a utility company had trimmed the trees around the area and did not remove the fallen debris.
- 2) A utility wire was draped off the side of the building and hung above a boat climbing structure on the playground. The wire is within reach of the children utilizing this climbing structure.

800 - Protective Surface Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (21) A protective surface shall:
- (a) Be provided for outdoor play equipment used to:
- 1. Climb;
- 2. Swing; and
- 3. Slide; and
- (b) Have a fall zone equal to the height of the equipment.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a castle climbing structure was placed within one foot of the chain-link fence on the playground. There was not a sufficient fall zone around this structure that was equal or greater to the height of the equipment.

805 - Fence Construction Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (24) Fences shall be:
- (a) Constructed of safe material;
- (b) Stable; and
- (c) In good condition.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the fence on the playground was in disrepair, the bottom portion of the chain-link was unwoven and not flush with the ground
