Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain adequate supervision in accordance with regulatory requirements. A staff member was observed exiting the one-year old classroom to retrieve cots from the three-year-old classroom. The staff was not within scope of vision of the six (6) children in the classroom. Interview with the staff revealed the children were one-year of age.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the record of the employee with the hire date of 05/20/1984 had met the requirement of Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment. Review of the ECE-TRIS training system indicated the above-mentioned employee had not met the requirement.
