General: Based on interview and review of documentation, out of fifteen staff files reviewed there were three staff (Hire dates: 8/16/2021, 8/23/2021 and 9/20/2021) who did not have evidence of having CPR/First Aid Training. This was also verified through ECE-TRIS. The staff person in charge indicated that the staff person hired 8/16/2021 is scheduled for certification training in CPR/FA at the end of October 2021.

General: Based on observation, two water-stained ceiling tiles were found in the indoor gross motor room.

690 - Sink Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the water temperature of the sink located in the Preschool Room was tested with a calibrated thermometer. It was found that the water temperature did not reach above 80 degrees Fahrenheit. The water temperature should be no less than 90 degrees Fahrenheit and not greater than 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

- (3) Rest time shall occur in an adequate space according to the child's age as follows:
- (a) For an infant:
- 1. An individual non-tiered crib that meets Consumer Product Safety Commission standards established in 16 C.F.R. 1219-1220;
- 2. A firm crib mattress in good repair with a clean tight-fitted sheet that shall be changed:
- a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet;

Findings:

General: Based on observation at the time of the survey, eight children ages 1 1/2 months to fifteen-months-old were in the indoor gross motor room when the surveyor arrived. The child who was 1 1/2 months old was observed sleeping on his back on a thick vinyl mat in an area surrounded by a low fence type enclosure with clear sides. Once the surveyor observed the infant sleeping in the area, a staff person woke the infant up and then took the child out of the enclosure. An infant is required to sleep in a crib with a firm mattress. It was not determined how long the child had been asleep.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the refrigerator in Classroom C did not have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature indicating device. Five individual cartons of milk were observed stored in the refrigerator.

1060 - Single Service Item **Not In Compliance**

- (8) A single-service item shall be:
- (a) Stored:
- (b) Handled and dispensed in a sanitary manner; and
- (c) Used only once.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the following was found:

- 1) The refrigerator in Classroom B contained three cups of milk with no lid or cover and four sippy cups of milk.
- 2) In the refrigerator in the Infant/Toddler Room, there were half full sippy cups of milk.

Interviews with staff in both rooms found the milk had been served to the children for breakfast. Staff confirmed that the remaining contents would be served to the children for lunch.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, it was found there was no documentation avaiable for reveiw at the survey to verify the names of the children in attendance during fire drills conducted during December 2020 - February 2021.

1305 - Fire Drills Not In Compliance

- (12) A fire drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least monthly; and
- (h) Documented
- (13) An earthquake drill, shelter-in-place or lockdown drill, and tornado drill shall be:
- (a) Conducted during hours of operation at least quarterly; and
- (b) Documented.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, it was found that monthly fire drills were not conducted at the facility for March and April of 2021. Staff stated in interview that during those two months only one classroom was in operation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a fish tank with several Goldfish was observed in Classroom B. Staff indicated they had obtained written permission from each parent except for one child. Staff indicated they would be obtaining the written permission the day of the survey. It should be noted that the child has been enrolled since 8/2/2021.
