- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on a review of documentation, staff member hired 8-10-16 only had the first page of the central registry check on file; therefore, it could not be verified that child abuse/neglect check had been processed. Interview determined the check had been completed but only the first page was copied for the file.

General: Based on observation, there were standing puddles of water under five (5) swings on the playground. Also, several long sections of weed block protruded through the protective surface. This created a tripping hazard.
