General: Based on observation, children's napping materials were individually stacked on a shelving unit labeled with the child's name within the One-Year-Old classroom; however, the stacks of bedding touched the neighboring stack. This method of storage promotes the spread of germs and bacteria.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a hire date was not documented for four individuals that were present on the date of the survey. The staff person in charge was able to verbally identify the date of hire for one staff member.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, three staff members with an unknown date of hire, and a staff member hired 2/1/2022, did not have documentation of educational qualifications in their personnel file.

405 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(1) Child-care center staff:

(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:

- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff members hired 5/10/2021, 6/24/19, 10/8/19, 2/1/2022, and a volunteer starting 1/27/2020, had a negative tuberculin skin result that exceeded two years in their personnel file. Additionally, three staff members with an unknown date of hire did not have a negative tuberculin skin result, nor a physician's statement clearing these individuals of active tuberculosis in their personnel file.

- (5) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and first aid training shall be in addition to the fifteen (15) clock hours requirement in subsection (16) of this section.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no documentation of a current CPR/First aid certification for any of the staff members. The staff person in charge stated that three of the staff had taken a certification class in the Summer of 2021, however the certification documentation could not be located.

540 - Bedding/Toys in Crib 922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements.

(3) Rest time shall occur in an adequate space according to the child's age as follows:

- (a) For an infant:
- 3. No bedding other than a clean tight-fitted sheet; and
- 4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, three crib sheets in the Infant classroom were loosely fitted onto the mattress and posed a suffocation hazard.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a wall within the One-Year-Old classroom had areas of chipping paint and drywall.

General: Based on observation, a carpeted toddler climbing apparatus within the One-Year-Old classroom was embedded with debris and was not clean.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, a toddler basketball goal was located within the Two-Year-Old classroom. The base was not weighed down with water or sand for stability as recommended by the manufacturer and presenting a toppling hazard.

General: Based on review of documentation, three children enrolled 4/30/2021, 8/9/2021, and 9/10/2021 had an immunization record in their enrollment file that was no longer current.

- (b) A written record for each child:
- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and

- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at a minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies;
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and

- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a child enrolled 11/17/2020, did not have a preferred hospital listed in their enrollment paperwork.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the emergency preparedness plan was last updated and sent to emergency management in March of 2020. The plan was not updated or sent prior to the December 31st, 2021, deadline for the 2022 year.
