General: Based on observation and review of documentation, Room 451 contained a posted daily plan of program activities (lesson plan) that was only labeled November. There was no weekly dates or a year documented on the lesson plan.

1325 - Daily Activities Not In Compliance

- (h) Post a schedule of daily activities, to include dates and times of activities to be conducted with the children in each classroom;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, a schedule of daily activities, including lists and dates of activities (daily schedule) to be conducted with the children was not posted in the Room 451.
