Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. During a review of children's files, a document signed by parents was reviewed. The document indicated that the facility would open at 8:00 a.m. for before care. The document also gave information regarding additional charges if a parent chooses to bring their child at 8:00 a.m. A review of information regarding the services and hours of operation of the program found that the program hours are 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Tuesday and Thursday. An interview with the staff person on charge found she had not notified the Division of Regulated Child Care of a change in hours of operation and there was no documentation to veirfy notification as well. The staff person in charge also indicated there had not been any parents that have utilized the earlier hours of operation.

There was no cover over the light bulbs and it could not be determined if the bulbs were shatterproof.
