# Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) In the Preschool 1 classroom, a cell phone charger's cord was hanging loosely from the wall creating a safety risk for the children.
- (2.) In the Preschool 2 classroom, several electrical cords were hanging loosely from the wall creating a safety risk for the children.

- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or

# Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the staff's (DOH: 6/1/17) file contained a negative tuberculin result that was completed on 9/21/15; therefore, the result is no longer current. During interview, staff reported having a current negative tuberculin result. A copy could not be provided during the surveyor's visit.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE - TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) Staff (DOH: 6/1/17) did not obtain the six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation within their first three (3) months of employment.
- (2.) Staff (DOH: 9/12/16) obtained six (6) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved early care and education training.
- (3.) Staff (DOH: 9/12/16) did not obtain the one and one half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training during their first year of employment.
- (4.) Staff (DOH: 7/8/16) obtained none of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved early care and education training.

- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (i) Allergies:
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) Child's (DOE: 10/30/15) file did not contain a preferred physician's telephone number.
- (2.) Child's (DOE: 10/3/17) file did not contain a preferred hospital's name or telephone number.
