- (2.) The handwashing sink located in the Preschool Classroom contained dark grime in the sink bowl; therefore, the sink was not clean.
- (3.) The handwashing sink located in the Ones Classroom contained black grime inside the sink bowl; therefore, the sink was not clean.
- (4.) A square rug, blue in color, located in the Ones Classroom contained debris; therefore, the rug was not clean.
