 - 1. An in-state criminal records check by:
 - a. Means of fingerprints for the state of residence; or
 - b. Any means accepted by a state of prior residency;
 - 2. A check of the state's sex offender registry or repository; and
 - 3. A check of the state-based child abuse and neglect registry and database; and

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with regulatory background checks requirements. Review of the presented employee records revealed a staff member with hire date 10/16/18 whose finger print report contained an Alabama address and whose file did not contain a Alabama background check. Upon request, the director did not present a Alabama background check for the aforementioned staff member at the time of the survey. Continued interview with the director revealed the staff member with hire date 10/16/18 had not worked alone with children. Observation of the center on 9/5/19 revealed the staff member with hire date 10/16/18 was not working alone with children.

Not In Compliance 390 - Educational Requirements Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files revealed a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential was not presented for review at the time of survey for three (3) staff members hired 8/27/19, 9/5/18 and 5/31/19. Interview with director revealed she acknowledged the deficiency.

395 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- . A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files revealed one (1) staff member hired 6/1/15 failed to have record of negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis on file. Interview with director revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.

Not In Compliance 410 - Training

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report on 9/5/19 revealed two (2) staff members with the hire dates of 1/15/19 and 5/31/19 had not completed state approved orientation training. Interview with owner revealed this documentation was not on file at the time of survey.

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain food service in accordance with regulations. Observation of the Wheat Room revealed the temperature of the refrigerator used to store children's lunches measured fifty (50) degrees Fahrenheit.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain written documentation in accordance with regulations. Review of documentation revealed an evacuation plan written for the center's current location was not presented for review at the time of survey. Interview with director revealed she needed to update the evacuation plan.
