General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 5/8/17, did not have documentation of education on file.

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 3/2/15, lacked fifteen (15) hours of training.

General: Based on Observation, fabric weed block was above the rubber mulch in several areas of the outdoor play area. This created a trip hazard.

- (2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:
- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a turquoise Bumbo Seat and a pink Bumbo Seat were in the infants' room. A review of the Consumer Product Safety Commission recall information determined the Bumbo Seats were recalled in 2007, and instructed consumers to order a free repair kit which included a restraint belt and a warning label. Interview determined the staff were unaware of the recall; therefore, the safety belt and warning label had not been obtained. A blue adult-size chair had an eight (8) inch crack on the back section of the chair and rust on the metal legs located in the outdoor play area.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a child enrolled on 2/1/17, did not include a name and phone number of an individual to be contacted in an emergency situation involving the child enrolled. Also, the name of each person designated to pick up the child was not in writing.
