General: Based on observation, the children's faces appeared flush in the two-year-old's room on 6/14/22. Interview determined the center's HVAC System was inoperable. The temperature in the two-year-old's room was eighty (80) degrees Fahrenheit on 6/14/22. An alternative cooling system was not in place.

- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

General: Based on interview, the center's HVAC system was inoperable and parts were needed for it to be repaired. Interview determined the HVAC system will be repaired on 6/18/22 or 6/19/22.
