- (3) A sink shall be:
- (a) Located in or immediately adjacent to toilet rooms;
- (b) Equipped with hot and cold running water that allows for hand washing;
- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

General: Based on the use of a thermometer to measure the temperature, the hot water measured 80 degrees Fahrenheit in the restroom sink next to the two and three year olds room and eighteen months olds' room.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, a 4oz tube of A&D with dimethazone and zinc oxide, two (2) 4oz tubes of Parents Choice diaper rash ointment, a 4oz and a 16oz tube of Boudreaux's Butt Paste and a 4oz container of Up & Up diaper rash paste were stored in cubbies in the Toddler's Room. A 4oz tube of Destin and a 4oz tube of Boudreaux's Butt Paste were stored in cubbies in the Infant's Room.
