Findings

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1. A staff person hired 5/18/2021, had addresses in Maryland and Delaware as a previous residence in the past five years. There was no evidence of a background check, CA/N check or a check of the state's sex offender registry from Maryland or Delaware on file in the facility.
- 2. A staff person hired 8/13/2019, had listed an address in Illinois as a previous residence in the past five years. There was no evidence of a background check, CA/N check or a check of the state's sex offender registry from Illinois on file in the facility.

- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff persons hired 7/20/2020, 9/15/2020, 2/23/2021, 2/8/2021, 5/18/2021 and 5/24/2021, did not have the results of or evidence of the application for a criminal background check on file in the facility.

- (1) A director shall:
- (m) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1. A staff person hired 7/20/2020, did not have the results of or evidence of the application for a criminal background check on file in the facility. The staff person was observed alone in a classroom with a group of seven three-year-old children.
- 2. Staff persons hired 2/8/2021 and 2/23/2021, did not have the results of or evidence of application for criminal background checks on file in the facility. The staff persons were observed caring for six children in the Infant classroom. There was no other qualified staff in the classroom.

- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, an employee hired 2/8/2021, did not have evidence of a high school diploma, GED or Commonwealth Child Care Credential on file in the facility.

395 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff persons hired 8/13/2019, 6/7/2021, and 2/23/2021, did not have documentation of negative T.B. results on file in the facility that had been obtained within the past two years.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1. Staff members hired on 12/9/2019 and 8/13/2019, did not complete the required PAHT training. These staff members have been employed for more than one year. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.
- 2. A staff member hired on 8/19/2002, did not complete the required PAHT renewal training within five years. The last training on file was completed 6/1/2016. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.

(1) An infant shall sleep or nap on the infant's back unless the infant's health professional signs a waiver that states the infant requires an alternate sleeping position.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, two 10-month-old children were observed sleeping in swings in the Infant classroom at 10:21 a.m. The same children were observed sleeping in the swings at 10:40 a.m. At 10:55 a.m. one of the children was still sleeping in the swing and the other had been removed from the swing.

- (8) An opening to the outside shall be effectively protected against the entrance of vermin by:
- (a) Self-closing doors;
- (b) Closed windows;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, upon entering the facility it was found that the door leading outside to the Toddler playground was being propped open. Their was no barrier in place to effectively protect against the entrance of vermin.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1. There was an area of chipping paint under the dry-erase board in the Twos classroom. The chipping left exposed dry wall material accessible to the children.
- 2. The door frame at the entrance of the Twos classroom had numerous areas of chipping paint, dirt and scuff marks.
- 3. There were four stained ceiling tiles in Room 108 and three stained ceiling tiles in Room 109.

650 - Toilet Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements.

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, there was a brown substance inside the toilet bowl in the bathroom in the Twos classroom. It could not be determined what the substance was at the time of the survey.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, there were two nap mats in the Toddler classroom and five nap mats in the Twos classroom that had several tears on the corners of the mats. This left exposed foam that can not be properly sanitized between uses.

General: Based on review of documentation, a child enrolled 6/6/2016, did not have information for a preferred hospital signed by the parent on file in the facility.

General: Based on observation, a current schedule of daily activities, including lists and dates of activities to be conducted with the children was not posted in the Infant classroom. The schedule of activities posted was from April 2021; however, the inspection was conducted in June 2021.
