922 KAR 2:090. Section 6. License Issuance.

- (5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:
- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and
- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. One (1) staff person (hire date: 2/15/17) had a criminal records check (CRC) that was submitted for processing on 2/22/17; therefore, it was not submitted within the regulatory time frame.

340 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, and the Training Records Information System (TRIS), one (1) staff file (hire date: 8/1/08) contained a pediatric abusive head trauma training class certificate that was dated 4/25/12; therefore, this training is no longer valid.

Findings

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. At the time of the survey it was found that the facility had a diagram posted; however, the facility did not have a written emergency plan posted outlining the course of action to be taken in the event of a fire. The staff person stated that she was not aware that this was missing from the board.
