385 - Personnel File

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. A review of staff files during the inspection found two staff that did not have the date of employment listed in their file. After looking at the school calendar, the staff person in charge presented the surveyor with an estimated start date of 9/28/20 for both staff.

The staff person in charge stated that she did not know the exact hire date for these two staff, but knows that they started after the facility re-opened on 9/28/20.
