General: Based on Review of Documentation and interviews, a toddler was left unattended on the outdoor playground for approximately three (3) minutes and twenty-six (26) seconds at 4:00 pm on 09/29/16.

<b>Findings:</b>	
General: Based on Review of Documentation, the center's supervision policy stated each time a group of children left the room, the children would be counted before leaving the room and counted again once the destination was reached. The supervision policy was not followed when a caregiver failed to count a group of children before leaving the playground and once again after they were inside the classroom. This failure resulted in a toddler being left alone on the outdoor playground for approximately three and a half (3 1/2) minutes on 09/29/16.
