General: Based on interviews and review of documentation, a 2016 Ford Econoline F550 transported a caregiver and seven (7) childcare children, age's four-months to four-years-old on 09/05/19. A review of the police report revealed the driver of the 2016 Ford Econoline F550 ran a red light at the intersection of West 18th Street and Frederica Street; therefore, putting the children's safety at risk. The 2016 Ford Econoline F550 hit a 2008 Chevrolet Impala, causing minor damage to the vehicles. A review of staff records determined there was no one employed by the childcare center, on the 2016 Ford Econoline F550, with the seven (7) children, who was currently certified in infant and child CPR and first aid.

On 09/05/19 from 2:46 pm until 4:18 pm, a caregiver supervised seven (7) children, age's four-months to four-years while on a 2016 Ford Econoline F550 bus. The bus was involved in an accident while transporting the seven (7) children.
