General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver hired on 10/14/21, did not have education verification on file.

#### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) caregivers, hired on 10/14/21 and 3/31/22, did not have TB documentation on file. A caregiver, hired on 1/23/18, had TB documentation dated 3/28/18. A caregiver, hired on 3/31/22, had TB documentation dated 9/25/19.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver hired on 10/14/19, completed twelve (12) hours of training during a subsequent year of employment. Three (3) caregivers, hired on 2/17/16, 1/9/18, and 1/23/18, did not complete any training hours during the subsequent year of employment. A caregiver, hired on 10/14/21, did not complete six (6) hours of cabinet approved orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment.

General: Based on interviews, monthly practiced fire drills were conducted but the dates, times and names of children who participated were not documented.
