General: Based on Interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. An interview with the director during the visit revealed that the facility is open 7:40AM - 3:25PM (M - F) which is different from the hours the hours they operated last school year. The facility did not submit written notification of this change to the cabinet.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (h) A written record of quarterly practiced earthquake drills and tornado drills detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;
- (i) A written record of practiced fire drills conducted monthly detailing the date, time, and children who participated in accordance with 922 KAR 2:120, Section 3;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, this regulatory requirement was not met. The director presented emergency drill documentation to the surveyor that had been documented by school administrative personel. The information contained a head count for the entire school on the drills that had been conducted. Fire drills were not conducted during the months of August, September, October or December; therefore, drills were not conducted monthly. The director stated, "Drills were conducted during these months; however, the information is on someone's computer that is not here today". A review of the documentation presented to the surveyor also found that the names of the children that participated in the drills was not listed.
