Findings:

A staff member hired on 8/01/2020, did not have written evidence of proof of submission or the results of the Ohio Child Abuse and Neglect Check (CAN) or the Sexual Offender Registry Check. The staff member was not observed working alone with the children.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Five staff did not have current staff evaluations on file.

- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A staff member hired on 8/01/2017, did not have written documentation of a completed KARES background check in their personnel file.
- 2. A staff member hired on 12/20/2017, did not have written documentation of an out-of-state background check in the personnel file. The staff member has lived in Ohio within the last five years.
- 3. Several of the staff files did not have documented hire dates. The staff in charge verbally provided the surveyor the missing hire dates.

Findings

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Seven staff files did not contain proof of education. These staff were hired on 8/01/2017, 10/18/2018, 7/01/2020, 8/01/2020, 9/01/2020, and 3/08/2021.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

Based on record review, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A staff member hired on 9/01/2020, did not complete the required Orientation I and II courses. This staff member has been employed for more than three months. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.
- 2. A staff member hired on 7/01/2020, did not complete the required Orientation I and II courses. This staff member has been employed for more than three months. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.
- 3. A staff member hired on 8/13/2019, did not complete the required Orientation I and II courses. This staff member has been employed for more than three months. The ECE-TRIS system and the staff file were reviewed.
- 4. A staff member hired on 9/04/2020, did not complete the required Orientation I and II courses. This staff member has been employed for more than three months. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.

- (c) Equipped with hot water at a minimum temperature of ninety (90) degrees Fahrenheit and a maximum of 120 degrees Fahrenheit;
- (d) Equipped with liquid soap;
- (e) Equipped with hand-drying blower or single use disposable hand drying material;
- (f) Equipped with an easily cleanable waste receptacle; and
- (g) Immediately adjacent to a changing area used for infants and toddlers.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The girls' bathroom located in the gym, did not have working hot water. The hot water faucet was turned on by the surveyor and no hot water came out. The cold water was working at the sink.

- 1. A child's enrollment paperwork was missing an immunization certificate. The child had been enrolled in excess of thirty days.
- 2. A child's enrollment paperwork contained an immunization certificate that was expired. The immunization was dated 4/01/2021. The child had been enrolled in excess of thirty days.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. Of the 10 children's files reviewed, none of the files contained a preferred hospital.
- 2. Of the ten children's files reviewed, seven were missing a physician's name and contact phone number.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Six staff did not have current professional development plans on file.

2. Written policy that states that the procedures that were taught at the orientation training shall be implemented by each child-care center staff member.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The facility did not have an orientation policy stating that the staff will implement the procedures that were taught at the orientation training.

- (1) An animal shall not be allowed in the presence of a child in care:
- (a) Unless:
- 1. The animal is under the supervision and control of an adult;
- 2. Written parental consent has been obtained; and
- 3. The animal is certified as vaccinated against rabies; or
- (b) Except in accordance with subsection (3) of this section.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Two classrooms contained fish and the facility did not have completed written parental consent forms indicating that the children can be in the presence of the fish.
