General: Based on Observation, the toilet in the Toddler II bathroom contained a green build-up around the hinge on the back of the toilet seat.

General: Based on Observation, a staff member in the two (2) year-old room changed a child's diaper and did not wash the child's hands. The staff member changed the child's diaper on the diaper changing table and then placed the child down in the classroom without washing his hands.

General: Based on Observation, the following items were unclean or in disrepair: 1) The inside of the doors that lead into the Toddler II bathroom contained areas of chipped paint. 2) The vent/fan unit in the ceiling of this bathroom was rusted. 3) The alphabet carpet in the Toddler II room contained black stains and spills around the letters. 4) The round metal climber on the playground contained areas of chipped metallic paint and areas of rust that were exposed under the chipped paint.

General: Based on Observation, and interview, the staff in charge indicated that the two (2) year-old children and the preschool age children are served two (2) percent milk for lunch. A gallon of two (2) percent milk was observed in the refrigerator in the hallway. Pasteurized low fat one (1) percent or fat-free skim milk shall be served to the children ages twenty-four (24) months to school-age.
