Findings: General: Based on observation, the surveyor found two water stained ceiling tiles upstairs, one in the hallway, and one in Classroom 202.

Findings: General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a diaper pad located in Classroom 102 in disrepair. The pad had exposed foam around the edges.

Excessive tape residue on top of a shelving unit located in the block center. 2. Five sections of chipped paint on the front doors of a storage cabinet. 3. Eight torn cardboard blocks in the block area.
