(22) If a child-care center does not have access to an outdoor play area, an indoor space shall:

(a) Be used as a play area;

(b) Have a minimum of sixty (60) square feet per child, separate from and in addition to the thirty-five (35) square feet minimum pursuant to subsection (6) of this section;

(c) Include equipment for gross motor skills;

(d) Be well-ventilated;

(e) Be heated; and

(f) Have a protective surface of at least two (2) inches thick around equipment intended for climbing.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a three (3) step climber/slide was directly on carpet; therefore, the equipment did not have a two inch protective surface material underneath in the infant/toddler room.

(a) Be helped with personal care and cleanliness based upon their developmental skills; and

(b) Wash his or her hands with liquid soap and warm running water:

1. a. Upon arrival at the center; or

b. Within thirty (30) minutes of arrival for school-age children;

2. Before and after eating or handling food;

3. After toileting or diaper change;

4. After handling animals;

- 5. After wiping or blowing nose;
- 6. After touching items soiled with body fluids or wastes; and
- 7. After outdoor or indoor play time.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, five (5) children, preschool to school-age, did not wash their hands upon arrival. Five (5) children, age preschool to school-age, did not wash their hands before they ate breakfast. Five (5) school-aged children and three (3) preschool children did not wash their hands after they ate breakfast.
