General: Based on Observation, black dust was around ceiling vent and ceiling in the preschool room.

General: Based on Observation, four (4) sheets were loose on four (4) crib mattresses in the infants' room.

General: Based on Observation, three (3) wooden planks, which lead to a slide on an outdoor playground apparatus, were broken. The three (3) planks had sharp points and one (1) plank had a raised nail. Two (2) yellow bars were loose which lead to a yellow barrel on the same outdoor playground apparatus. Also, based on interview, the metal bar was broken on the exit door to the outdoor playground.
