General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A staff's (DOH: 01/16/2020) file did not contain a staff evaluation.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 12/03/1985) file contained a staff evaluation dated 2/10/2021; therefore, the staff evaluation was not conducted yearly.
- 3. A staff's (DOH: 05/14/2014 file did not contain a staff evaluation.

Staff reported that she would have the staff evaluations completed.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor discovered a staff's (DOH: 01/16/2020) file contained a negative tuberculin (TB) skin test dated for 11/17/2019; therefore, the TB verification was no longer current. The surveyor was unable to verify if the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.

Staff reported that she would have the staff bring in an updated negative TB skin test.



435 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and ECE- TRIS, the surveyor found that a staff (DOH:02/20/2017) completed the one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma (PAHT) on 02/08/2017; therefore, PAHT training was not completed once every five (5) years.

Staff reported that she would have the staff member complete her training.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor discovered in the restroom off from the nursery that the toilet seats were loose; therefore, the toilet seats were not in good repair.

Staff reported that she would have the toilet seats fixed.
