- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, staff member hired 06/22/20, completed the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 06/08/13, but failed to complete the training again every five (5) years. In addition, Staff member hired 08/06/14, completed the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training on 03/21/16, but failed to complete the training again every five (5) years.
