Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulation was not met. The following was found:

- 1.) There was a stained ceiling tile in the Preschool 2 classroom and three large holes in the wall.
- 2.) The Pre-K 1 room had a broken ceiling tile and four small holes in the wall.
- 3.) In the shared boys bathroom, there was an area of chipping paint above the urinals and broken wall tiles.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, this regulation was not met. Out of the ten files presented for inspection, the following was found:

- 1.) Six were missing emergency care authorization information.
- 2.) Eight were missing children's identifying information.
- 3.) Eight did not have parent contact information.
- 4.) One was missing a physician's contact information.
- 5.) Three did not have an authorized pick up list.
- 6.) Eight did not have a preferred hospital listed.
