General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the girls' restroom; therefore, the toilet was not kept in good repair.

Therefore, the diaper changing surfaces were not kept clean.

- 1. A crib located in the Infants Classroom had a mattress that contained dirt & stains on top of the mattress; therefore, the crib was not kept in clean condition.
- 2. A crib located One's Classroom contained dirt on top of the mattress; therefore the crib was not kept in clean condition.

- 1.The following children's (DOE: 1/4/22, 4/4/21 and 1/4/22) files did not contain the contact telephone number for the children's preferred family physician.
- 2. A child's (DOE: 11/23/21) file did not contain the name or contact telephone number of the child's preferred hospital.
