Review of staff files revealed a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential was not presented for review at the time of survey for two (2) staff members hired 1/14/2020 and 3/9/2020. Interview with the staff in charge revealed the documents were not there for review. In Compliance Programming Not In Compliance Premises 650 - Toilet Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements. (4) Each toilet shall: (a) Be kept in clean condition; (b) Be kept in good repair; (c) Be in a lighted room; and (d) Have ventilation to outside air. Findings: General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulatory requirements. Interview with the director and an observation of the toilet in the two's room #3 bathroom revealed the toilet did not flush. Interview with the staff in charge revealed that the toilet was not flushing.
