- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor learned that:

- 1. Two (2) staff members (DOH: 02/02/2021 and 05/24/2021) did not have the Child Abuse and Neglect Checks, and
- 2. One (1) staff member (04/27/2021) did not have the criminal records background check.

Therefore, the center did not have the required completed background checks for three (3) staff members. The surveyor did not witness any of the staff members working alone while completing the survey. During interview, staff stated that the three (3) staff members have not worked alone in the classroom(s) with the children. The surveyor did see documentation in the staff members' files where the background checks had been requested. The surveyor did not find documentation that the staff members' had been submitted to KARES.

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor learned that a staff's (DOH: 01/10/21) file did not contain a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential. During interview, staff confirmed the documentation was not obtained for the staff's file.

- (3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:
- 3. No loose bedding, such as a bumper or a blanket; and
- 4. No toys or other items except the infant's pacifier;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, During a tour of the Nursery #1 Classroom, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. Two (2) infants were asleep in their cribs with a pacifier attached to a clip; therefore, creating a choking hazard.
- 2. One (1) infant was drinking a bottle while lying in their crib; therefore, creating a choking hazard.

During interview, staff stated they were aware that these incidents were a choking hazard and would instruct staff in protocol and procedures.

Findings:

General: During a tour of the center, the surveyor found an open container of sanitizing wet wipes located on the floor and on low shelves in the restroom used by the two-year-old children. The wipes label indicated the wipes should be "kept out of the reach of children". The wipes were within reach and accessible to the children. During interview, staff stated the wet wipes shall be removed.

Findings:

Based on observation, during a tour of the Nursery #1 Classroom, the surveyor found that one (1) infant was drinking a bottle while lying in their crib; therefore, the child was not held while bottle feeding.

During interview, staff stated that they were aware this incident could cause a choking hazard and would instruct staff in proper bottle feeding for infants.
